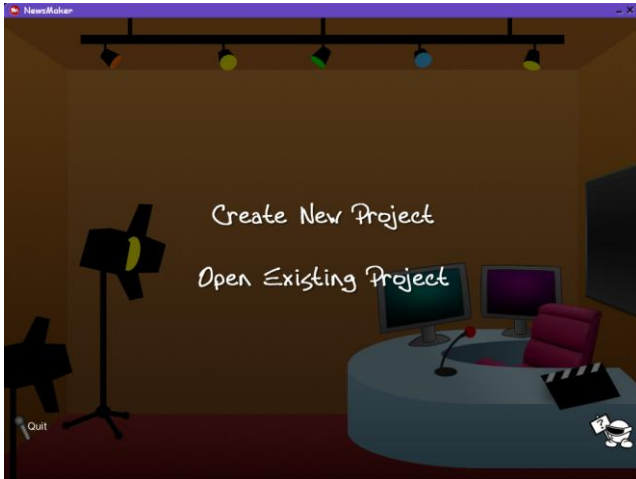




Startup Screen - What you can do here



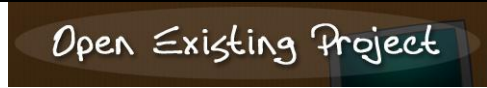
You can do the followings:

1. [Create a new project](#)
2. [Open an existing project](#)

Create a new project	
<p>1. Click on "Create New Project"</p>	
<p>2. Enter a unique project name. In this example, "Sample Project" is used as the project name.</p> <p>Choose a directory to save your project. Make sure you choose a directory that you have privilege to save your project to. In this example, the "D" directory is chosen.</p> <p>You may click on the button with "..." to select the directory.</p>	
<p>3. Click OK to proceed to Step 1: Story Composing.</p>	
<p>4. What has happened right now is that a Project Folder and a Project File under the project name that you have specified has been created in the directory that you have chosen.</p> <p>In this example, a "Sample Project" folder has been created and a "Sample Project.nmp" file has also been created.</p>	

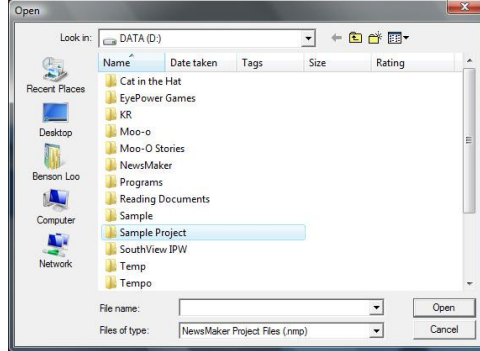
Open an existing project

1. Click on “Open Existing Project”



2. Select the project folder in the directory that you have saved your project to.

In this example, the project is created in “D” drive and the project folder is called “Sample Project”



3. You should be able to find the project file (With “.nmp” as an extension). Select that file and click open. Or jus double click on that file.

In this example, the project file is “Sample Project.nmp”.
