
## Step 1: Story Composing - What you can do here

## Edit a story 1. To edit a story, select the story on the "List of Stories" panel and click the "Edit" button. Edit

## Arrange the sequence of the story

 If you have more than one story and you need to arrange them in the correct sequence, select the story on the "List of Stories" panel and click either the "Move up" or "Move down" button to move the story to the correct position in the list.
